Europe is a market full of opportunities for seafood exporters. The European seafood consumption market is expected to continue to grow due to increased awareness of the health benefits of seafood and the rising demand for sustainable and eco-friendly seafood options. The European seafood market was valued at USD 34.1 billion in 2020 and is projected to reach USD 40.6 billion by 2026, growing at a CAGR of 2.8% during the forecast period (2021-2026).

The Seafood Expo Global is the largest seafood trade show in the world. Seafood Expo Global promotes seafood and aquaculture products from the SUSTA region to both European and worldwide seafood buyers. Every year, Seafood Expo Global/Seafood Processing Global continues to break records in terms of total attendance and exhibit space. The last edition, in 2022, hosted more than 26,630 seafood buyers and suppliers from around the globe with over 1,550 exhibiting companies from 76 different countries.
