CBD has grown exponentially in popularity over the last few years due to medicinal properties shown through its use in dietary and nutritional supplements. In addition to possessing natural anti-inflammatory properties, CBD has also been shown in clinical research to provide positive results in the reduction of symptoms associated with anxiety, cognition, movement disorders, chronic pain and PTSD. The United States has only recently legalized hemp production, opening it up for exports. The target audience is UK and EU CBD oil manufacturers looking for CBD extract and CBD flower. The first edition of the Hemp & CBD Expo in the NEC Exhibition Center in 2019 hosted 119 exhibitors, with 4,000 trade visitors. The show does not only cover food but also cosmetics, clothing and building material.
